The Palms of God's Hands

The LORD gave me this Word on the morning of August 10, 2026.

"Tell My People that it is time to know and understand that I am being very intentional with and in their lives. I have always been and will be intentional with their life, but few receive My intentionality—My being deliberate and purposeful; but they MUST to hear and know NOW."

The LORD—EL SHADDAI says, "I cannot be intentional with you right now if you want to run your own life. The controlling of self is a barrier between you and I. I had your life before you did, but many—even my own are often found taking control of their own life by being self-sufficient. And, as a result, they are not experiencing Me as El-Shaddai (All-Sufficient One, All-Mighty One) and the liberty and blessing I have for them. They are not experiencing the power that comes from My Right Hand—the power of being in the PALMS OF MY HANDS."

The FATHER says, *"Indeed, I have inscribed [a picture of] you on the Palms of My hands; . . ."*

"I want anyone who will, to come and sit in the PALMS OF MY HANDS. And, I want them to stay there, because the time is short and of the essence. However, while many may come to sit in the PALMS OF MY HANDS, they keep jumping out! But now I am telling you to COME. STAY. SIT. REST.

"In the PALM OF MY HAND is safety, love, hope, faith, power, prosperity, sanctification, healing, freedom, answers, ideas, solutions, abundant life and more. When you SEE from My Palm, the view is different: there is insight, knowledge, revelation, wisdom and clarity for things you need to see and have breakthrough in. No one can sit or position themselves in the PALMS OF MY HANDS and not experience breakthrough! IN MY PALM is rest! IN MY PALM is peace—Shalom [wholeness—nothing missing, nothing broken]! IN MY PALM is joy! IN MY PALM you cannot be robbed from! The thief cannot touch you IN MY PALM!

"Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest," (Matthew 11:28). Come, all who need answers. Come, all who need healing and freedom. Come, all who desire to advance!" Come, all who need breakthrough! says the Spirit of God! "Come right now!" Says the LORD, El-Shaddai!



FURTHER STUDY and MEDITATION ON THE PALMS OF GOD'S HANDS:

Isaiah 49:16-19 TPT—*"Can't you see? I have carved your name on the PALMS OF MY HANDS! ¹⁷Your walls are always my concern. Your children, your builders, are turning back to you as those who ruined and destroyed you are running away. ¹⁸ lift up your head and look all around you. See! All your children, your builders, gathered to come back to you. As surely as I live, I make this promise, says Yahweh. You will wear them all like jewels, as a radiant bride wears her beautiful jewelry! ¹⁹ See! Your ruins and devastated places will soon be overcrowded with settlers while your destroyers stay far away."*

John 10:29 AMP—*"My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater and mightier than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's HAND."*

Psalm 139:8-10—*"If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there.*

⁹ If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, ¹⁰ even there YOUR HAND will guide me, your RIGHT HAND WILL HOLD ME fast."

- **Protection.** The Palm of God's hands symbolize God's divine protection, constant care, and guidance in our lives where God promises to shield and safeguard His people from harm. It signifies His intimate knowledge of us and His constant support through all circumstances. (Psalm 121:7-8; Psalm 91:1; Isaiah 41:10)
- **Trust and Faith.** Trust in God and having faith in His plan for us is another important aspect—as believing God holds us in the Palms of His Hands requires a deep sense of trust and faith in His goodness and sovereignty. (Proverbs 3:5-6; Hebrews 11:1;6; Mark 11:23-24)
- **Providence.** As being in the Palms of God's hands, also refers to God's Providence over us. The concept of God's Providence refers to His divine guidance and *provision* in our life. Just as loving parents care for their children, God watches over us and *provides for all our needs*, ensuring that we are always in His care. (Matthew 6:33; Philippians 4:19; Psalm 37:25; Matthew 6:26)
- **Sovereignty.** The Bible teaches that God is Sovereign and in charge of all things. Being held in the Palms of His hands signifies His supreme authority and power over our lives, reminding us that we are safe and secure in His hands in ALL or every area of life. (Psalm 115:3; Romans 11:36; Ephesians 1:11; Colossians 1:16)

Pastor Bill Johnson's quote on God's Sovereignty is worth thinking about: He emphasizes that while God is Sovereign, He is *not* in CONTROL of every circumstance. God is in CHARGE, but does not orchestrate every event, particularly those involving evil or suffering.
